

#### **About Brain & Brain PET**

Brain & Brain PET 2023 is one of the top neuroscience symposiums, with a focus on research related to brain function and metabolism, cerebral blood flow, the function of the neurovascular unit and the blood-brain barrier, brain imaging, and cerebrovascular pathology. The research presented at BRAIN meetings is highly relevant to stroke, dementia, brain injury and other neurological conditions. As such the meeting attracts a broad range of delegates, both preclinical and clinical. The aim of the meeting is to provide an exciting and dynamic forum for the leading researchers in the field to present and discuss their work, and to inspire the next generation of scientists.

#### **Our Goal**

The Brain & Brain PET 2023 local organising committee will work closely with the program committee of the International Society for Cerebral Blood Flow and Metabolism (ISCBFM) to put together an outstanding scientific program that will attract a broad range of researchers, from cell biologists and basic neuroscientists to clinicians. The research presented at the meeting will cover a broad range of topics that utilise a multitude of experimental techniques and approaches, covering antibodies to radiotracer development, high-resolution microscopy to in vivo imaging (i.e. PET, MR, multiphoton) and from preclinical testing to clinical evaluation.





  - **(c)** It is the intention of the Parties that this clause will supplant the common law doctrine of frustration and the operation of the *Frustrated Contracts Act 1978* (NSW) and equivalent legislation in other jurisdictions, to the extent applicable..
- 19. Late Bookings are possible, but choices may be limited. Exhibition space contracted less than four (4) weeks prior to the Event start date will be charged a 15% surcharge.
